On October 30, 2018, the undersigned Agent testified in a hearing before United States District Court Judge Mark Walker regarding a motion to suppress evidence collected pursuant to a number of search warrants, which was filed by Defense on October 15, 2018.

The undersigned Agent was provided a copy of the motion on October 17, 2018.

Because the AUSA formerly assigned the case, Jason Beaton, resigned from the service of the United States Attorney's Office, the case was reassigned to AUSA Gary Milligan. (Note: that event was not effectively memorialized in the case file, but occurred in the beginning of August, 2018).

As AUSA Milligan is relatively new to the case, the undersigned Agent prepared a written response to the various issues addressed in the motion to suppress in order to assist AUSA Milligan in drafting the Government's response. That document was provided, in draft form, to the AUSA at the conclusion of each day until completed on October 25, 2018. The final version of that document is attached to this FD-302.

Also attached to this FD-302 are Defense's motion to suppress along with accompanying exhibits.

During the hearing, Defense introduced a binder of exhibits, admitted by stipulation from the Government. Those exhibits are also attached to this FD-302.

At the conclusion of the undersigned Agent's testimony, Judge Walker paused the hearing, as Defense intended to call Justin Lewis and anticipated his testimony would be lengthy. Instead of halting in the middle of Lewis' testimony, Judge Walker put the second part of the hearing on the motion to suppress on the calendar for November 26, 2018.
